**Camp Locations – Drop-off and Pickup:**

- **All Weeks:** Good Counsel High School, 17301 Old Vic Blvd., Olney, Maryland 20832. Registration is usually on the left side of school; turn into the parking area before you pass the building.
- For pick-up, same area – **parents must park and come sign-out campers.**
- **Visit the website before camp for more specific registration directions & parking information.**

**Day Camp Daily Schedule:**

- Camp hours are from 9:00 - 3:00. Children may be dropped off after 8:30. On Monday, we would like to check campers at in between 8:30 and 8:50 and verify information such as current emergency phone numbers. At this time please make us aware of any special needs, disabilities, allergies, etc.

**What to Bring:**

- LUNCH: You may bring a bag lunch. We will NOT be able to offer pre-ordering pizza as in the past, but GC will be running a snack bar. More details will be online and available at camp.
- All campers must wear shin guards and cleats. (For the youngest campers, cleats are optional). Cleats have to be removed before entering school, so be sure your child can identify his own.
- Goalkeepers should bring their own gloves and shirt.
- Don't forget sunscreen, and a hat or visor if necessary.
- Water and cups will be available at all times; however, it is recommended that you bring your own water bottle to keep with you on the fields.
- Also bring indoor shoes in case we go inside because of weather.

**After Care:** If After Care is noted above after “Amount Due”, then you are registered. If you would like to add, please see our website for details. After Care is for the full week; all campers signed up will be picked up there.

**Inclement Weather:**

- There is shelter for brief or light rain. For extended period of rain, camp may be delayed or suspended; we will always have indoor areas for the normal camp hours, but may not often have the room for soccer activities. Call the camp line at (301) 570-0318 for any messages after 7:45 A.M. You may also check the website or Facebook. Also, please be sure the camp has the correct phone number to reach the person responsible for pick-up in case of early dismissal.

**MSA Refund Policy:** (if you registered through GC, their policy may apply)

- Full refunds will be made for any reason prior to May 1st.
- After May 1st, and until two weeks before a camp session, refunds will be made minus a registration fee.
- No refunds can be made unless requested prior to 14 days before a camp session.
- After the 14 days or for sickness or injury during camp, make up days will be offered or a credit for future.
