### Camp Locations – Drop-off and Pickup:

- **All Weeks:** Good Counsel High School, 17301 Old Vic Blvd., Olney, Maryland 20832.
- Usually left side of school - For pick-up, same area as Drop off– **parents must park and come pick up campers.**
- **Look for our e-mails or visit the website for more specific registration directions & parking information.**

### Day Camp Daily Schedule:

- Camp hours are from 9:00 - 3:00. Children may be dropped off after 8:30. On Monday, we would like to check campers at in between 8:30 and 8:50.

### What to Bring:

- SHIN GUARDS and CLEATS: All campers must wear. (For the youngest campers, cleats are optional). Cleats have to be removed before entering school, so be sure your child can identify his own.
- Goalkeepers should bring their own gloves and shirt.
- LUNCH: You may bring a bag lunch.. GC will be running a weekly lunch plan. See GC system to add.
- Don't forget sunscreen, and a hat or visor if necessary.
- Bring your own water bottle (with your name on it) to keep with you on the fields.
- Also bring indoor shoes in case we go inside because of weather.

**After Care:** If After Care is noted above after “Amount Due”, then you are registered After Care is for the full week; All campers signed up will be picked up there. To add, log into GC system and *View Submitted Applications, Review Details, Add Options, Show Details*, then add After -Care or Lunch.

### Inclement Weather:

- There is shelter for brief/light rain. For extended period of rain, or heat, camp may be delayed or suspended; we will always have indoor areas for the normal camp hours, but may not often have the room for soccer activities. Call the camp line at (240)389-2840 for any messages after 7:45 A.M. You may also check the website or Facebook. Also, please be sure the camp has the correct phone number for pick-up in case of early dismissal.

### Required Forms:

- See MSA or GC website for link to required medical forms. Then log into GC system, *View Submitted Applications, View Details, Upload forms.*

### MSA Refund Policy

- No refunds can be made unless requested prior to 14 days before a camp session.
- Full refunds will be made for any reason prior to May 1st.
- After May 1st, and until two weeks before a camp session, refunds will be made minus a registration fee.
- After the refund window or for sickness or injury during camp, make up days will be offered or a credit for future.

**Contacting Camp:** If you need to contact camp for an emergency communication only, call 240-354-3843 or the GC front desk at 240-283-3200. **High School Prep Sessions:**

Camp is 6:00 – 8:00, Monday through Thursday. Please arrive by 5:45 on Monday for check-in. It will usually be on the Rt 108 field, left side of school.

Please bring a ball, water bottle and shoes for indoor play in case of heat/rain.

If camp has to move indoors, campers should be in the Kane center, on the opposite side of the school from Rt 108 field. We will update you by e-mail if we know ahead of time, or check our phone message or website.
